The Faith Habit of Reading Scripture

If you would like to try the faith habit of reading scripture, choose a short passage daily. Read it 2-3 times. Be silent for a few minutes allowing the scripture to soak in. The passage might lead you into prayer. Following are a few suggestions, or use your Bibles to find some verses.

Do not worry about anything, but in all your prayers ask God for what you need, always asking with a thankful heart. And God's peace which is far beyond human understanding, will keep your hearts and minds safe in union with Christ Jesus.

—Philippians 4:6-7

Peace I leave with you. It is my own peace that I give to you. I do not give peace as the world does. Do not be worried and upset. Do not be afraid.
