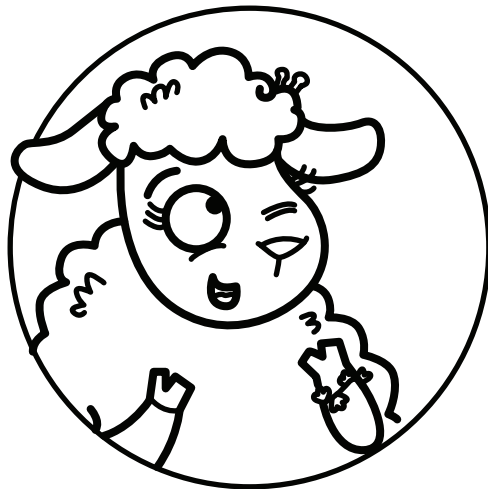
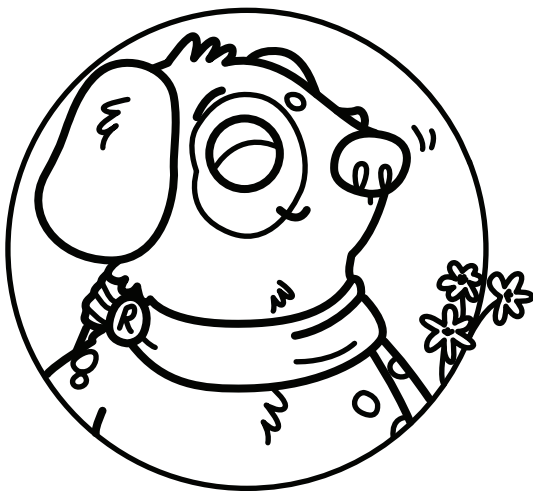
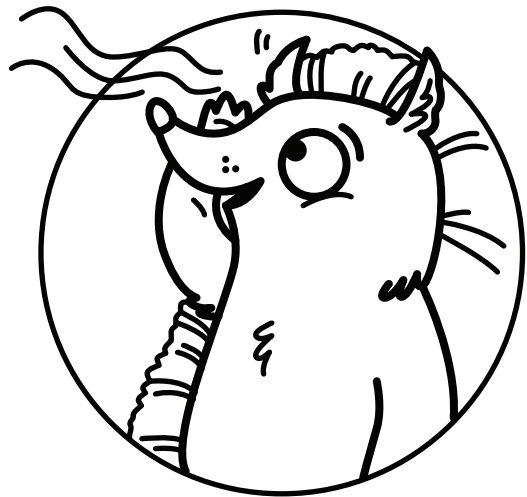


Dear God,

Mini Lesson: Board Book

STORY: **God's Wonderful World**

THEME: **God gave us a wonderful world to see, hear, taste, smell, and touch.**

Read the Story

Sit in a low chair or on the floor with the board book titled *God's Wonderful World*. Ring a chime or use another sound to call children to story time. Gather them into a story-time circle.

What do you use to taste? Tongue or mouth. **What do you use to touch?** Hands. **What do you use to smell?** Nose. **What do you use to hear?** Ears. **What do you use to see?** Eyes. **Let's hear a story about the wonderful world God made for us to see, hear, taste, smell, and touch!**

Hold up *God's Wonderful World* and read the story. Finish your storytelling with this statement: **God gave us a wonderful world to see, hear, taste, smell, and touch!**

More Story Fun

Open the book to the picture that shows the five Frolic animals using their five senses. Hold up the picture for all children to see.

Point to Jo. **Jo is using his mouth to taste yummy berries. What are your favorite foods to taste?**

Point to Uri. **Uri is using her wings to touch the cool water. What kinds of things do you touch with your hands?**

Point to Hal. **Hal is using his ears to hear a cheerful song. What are your favorite songs to hear?**

Point to Rufus. **Rufus is using his nose to smell the sweet flowers. What are your favorite things to smell?**

Point to Ava. **Ava is using her eyes to see the beautiful sunset. What do you see with your eyes? There are so many things in God's world that we can see, hear, taste, smell, and touch!**

Prayer

Finish your time together with a prayer.
