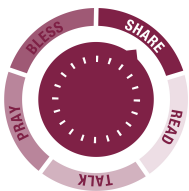

Today's God's Great Story is Paul's message about our victory over death in

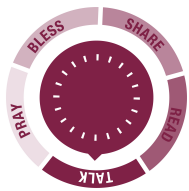
1 Corinthians 15: 51-58

These verses talk about being raised with Christ, what does that look like in your imagination?

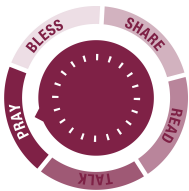
How are you being “resurrected” on a daily basis?

Read Ecclesiastes 3:1-8. With each line there are 2 “times”, raise your left thumb if you feel like you're in that time and raise your right thumb if you feel more in that time.



For everything there is a season, and a time for every matter under heaven:

a time to be born, and a time to die;

a time to plant, and a time to pluck up what is planted;

a time to kill, and a time to heal;

a time to break down, and a time to build up;

a time to weep, and a time to laugh;

a time to mourn, and a time to dance;

a time to throw away stones, and a time to gather stones together;

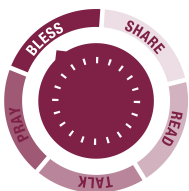
a time to embrace, and a time to refrain from embracing;

a time to seek, and a time to lose;

a time to keep, and a time to throw away;
