


# Water to Wine

John 2:1-11



Jesus, his mother, and his disciples were invited to a wedding in Cana. When wine at the party ran out, Jesus told the servants to fill six huge empty jars with water. Jesus told them to take some of the liquid from the jars to the steward. When the steward tasted the liquid, it was not water, but wine. Jesus had performed his first miracle in John, turning water into wine.


## Take a Look

Here are some of the people and things in today's story. What can your child tell you about them?



**Mary, Jesus' mother,** told Jesus that there was no more wine at the wedding. She knew that Jesus would be able to fix the problem.

**Jesus** knew how embarrassing it was to run out of wine at a wedding, so he helped out by turning some water into wine.



**Wine** was important for wedding celebrations. It was also important in Jesus' life, especially at the Last Supper.

There was a wedding in Cana. Soon, the wedding hosts ran out of wine. Mary, Jesus' mother, asked Jesus to intervene. He turned jugs of water into wine, right before the servants' eyes. It was Jesus' first miracle.


Dear Jesus, when you saw a need, you made a change. Help us see needs all around us and act in ways that make positive changes. Amen!
