


Jesus Feeds 5,000

John 6:1-14



Huge crowds of people gathered on the shore of the Sea of Galilee to see Jesus. Jesus wanted his disciples to feed the crowd. They found a boy who had just five loaves of bread and two fish, but Jesus assured them that would be enough. The five loaves and two fish fed 5,000 people, with twelve baskets left over!

Here are some of the people and things in today's story. What can your child tell you about them?



While teaching on the mountain, **Jesus** provided more food than the whole crowd could eat, just like the wine at the wedding at Cana.



The **crowd** went out to see Jesus, but they had nothing to eat. Afterwards, they believed Jesus was a powerful prophet.



The **disciples** followed Jesus to help and learn from him. A group of generous women supported them.

About the Video

Although the crowd loved listening to Jesus, they were getting hungry. Some people had brought food, but others hadn't, and no one was willing to share. Then a small boy gave Jesus five loaves and two fish, and Jesus turned it into a feast of plenty.

Prayer


Dear God, for the food we eat, and the people we meet, for the ways that we care and the ways that we share, we give you thanks, O God! Amen!
