Look at the Heart Activity

Let's do this activity together on Sunday, February 28, 2021 via Zoom! If you miss the Zoom session you can follow the instructions below.

Supplies Included: Paper square, heart cutout **Supplies Needed:** Coloring supplies and writing utensil





Step 1: Hold the heart cutout on the white paper and add color to the white parts of the paper. Be careful not to move the paper heart and get color under the heart.

Step 2: Once the heart is colored you can add the Bible statement:

"The Lord looks at the heart

1 Samuel 16:7"



"Samuel was called to anoint a new king for Israel. This new king wasn't just going to be a political leader. As the head of God's people, the king would need to be strong in faith and rich in mercy. Despite some more likely candidates, God picked David, the youngest and smallest of Jesse's sons. Like many God has chosen throughout history, David was a surprising choice, but he was a man after God's own heart—a man of righteousness."



Step 3: Cut out your and glue on the flame and fonts you want. Make sure you put glue over the top of paper cutouts.

TIP: The glue dries clear, so you can put enough on to cover the whole project.

Step 4: Once your project is completely dry, may take up to half a day, flip it over. Use a scissors to carefully cut the scraps off of the edges.





Step 4: Use the tip of the scissors to remake the holes of the wooden plaque. Then, thread the twine through the holes. Tie the twine at the length you would like.

Display your "Here I am" craft as a reminder of the story of God speaking to Moses through the Burning Bush. And as a reminder that God calls us. Even when we doubt our own abilities we can say, "Here I am!" and God accepts us for who we are and where we are at!
