Adult Enrichment & Faith Formation Activities

Nativity provides a variety of opportunities for spiritual deepening as individuals and in community. Where is God calling you today? We invite you to explore that call through adult faith formation and enrichment activities.

- Vital Aging: Nativity values its senior members. Many of these opportunities are during the day to accommodate retirement or semi-retirement schedules.
- Spiritual Coaching: A one-to-one ministry with a trained spiritual director for the purpose of questioning and growing in faith while balancing the challenges of life.
- Adult Bible Study: Wednesday Morning Bible Study meets at Nativity (and online) every Wednesday 10:00-11:30 am. We study the scriptures, their historical context, and ways they apply today.
- Book Groups: Nativity hosts a variety of book groups covering spiritual topics and social justice issues that challenge and deepen our faith. Groups meet in person or online Saturday well as Tuesday and Thursday mornings.

You'll find many other enrichment opportunities at Nativity, including weekly yoga classes, the Prayer Shawl ministry, contemplative activities, Sunday adult faith formation sessions, LSS women's group, and more.

Children, Youth & Family Ministries at Nativity

Nativity offers year-round activities for children and youth, including Sunday faith formation classes, music groups, summer programs, service & learning trips, confirmation, and more.

Nativity is a loving community where kids and their families can practice faith habits like prayer, worship, Bible study, giving, and service to others. Nativity partners with parents to nurture faith by encouraging kids to love God and love our neighbor.

During the school year, our children's choirs (Ages 4- Grade 6) practice on Wednesday evenings, building community, sustaining learning and creativity, and preparing music for worship.

In high school, we focus on service projects, peer support, leadership skills, and building community. Students will explore their personal relationship with God and define what they believe. Not only are teens able to learn and grow as people, but they'll be part of a supportive community that has a lot of fun together!
